Format Links: Area of home page with KCLS resource formats listed in large, bold type. When the user mouses over any of the formats (Books, Music, Movies, etc.), the link becomes "hot" (indicated by changing color). In addition, when the user mouses over any of the formats, the background image changes, giving it a dynamic, interactive feel.

Featured Event Slideshow: Image with text and Forward/Back controls that highlights upcoming special events, announcements, or program (Examples: Summer Reading Program, The Children Left Behind program, etc.). This will be implemented in a way that is easily updated by the KCLS Web Services Team.

Global Navigation Links: Includes brief descriptions of and links to service category sections of the site. Items listed in each category will be live links (graphical style will change on hover to give user an indication that it is a link). Graphical style will be mirror that of the tabs in the global navigation header.

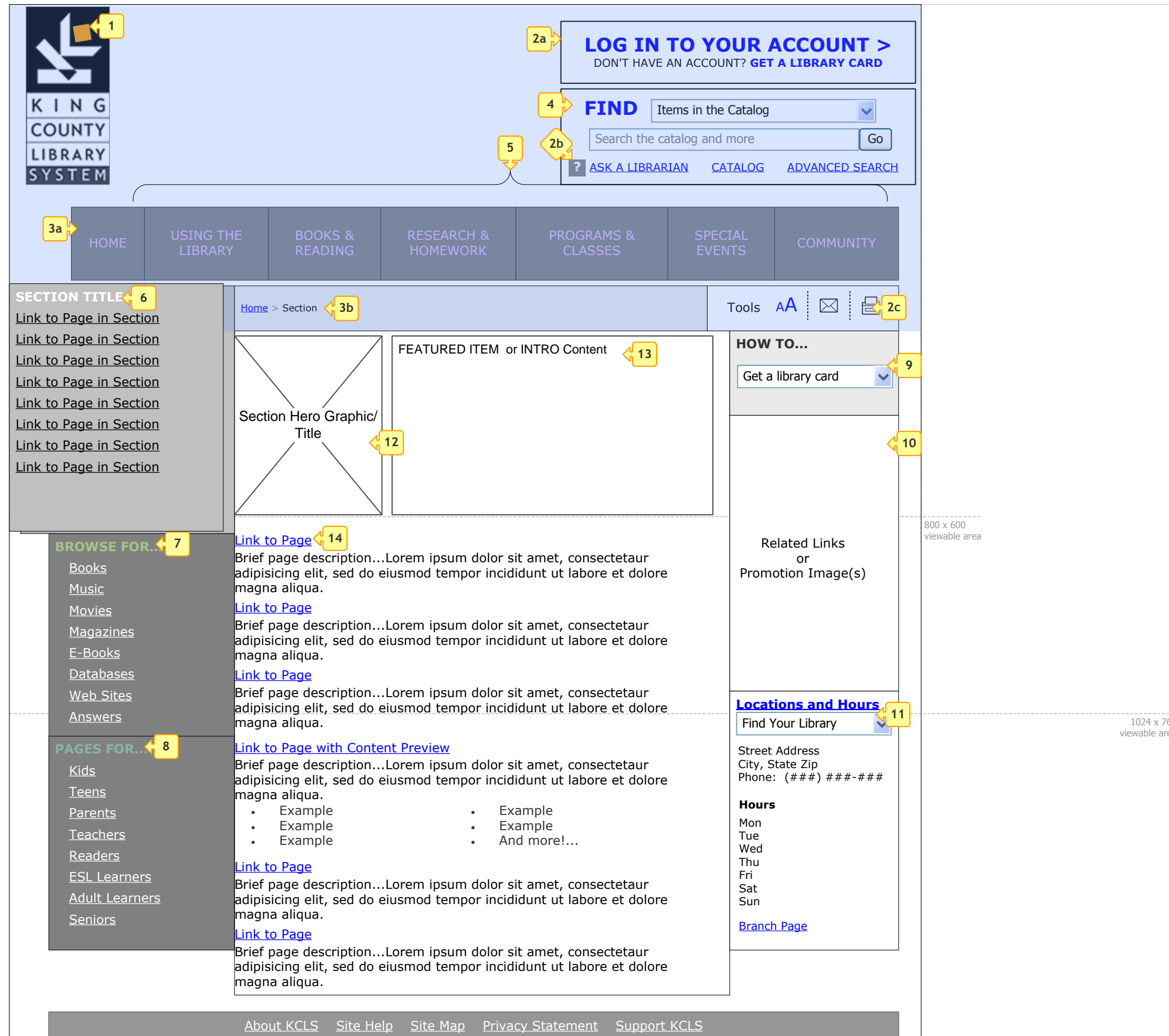

Site Masthead Elements

The area of this page highlighted in light blue is the KCLS.org site masthead, which will appear at the top of every page on the site. The masthead includes five important elements that users need to have on hand at all times.

- 1 Site ID:** The KCLS logo in the upper left corner of every page on the site signals to the user that he is on the KCLS site. (The logo also acts as a hyperlink to the KCLS home page. See #3 below.)
- 2 Site Utilities:**
 - 2a. Log in to your account (2a): See login experience page for description.
 - 2b. Ask A Librarian (2b): Links to the Ask a Librarian page, which gives the users options to call, e-mail or chat online.
 - 2c. Page tools (2c): Change text size on this page, e-mail this page, print this page.
- 3 A direct path home:** Users should have a quick, obvious, direct way to get back to the home page. They actually will get this three ways:
 - 3a. Via the "Home" tab on the global navigation;
 - 3b. Via the breadcrumbs;
 - and via the KCLS logo. (See #1 above.)
- 4 A way to search:** The FIND area under the login utility allows users to not only search the KCLS catalog but also databases, recommended websites and the KCLS.org site itself. (The user has several search scopes to choose from, with the most popular listed first.) [See Component - Basic Search page for a description of this component.]
- 5 Global navigation:** These link to the main sections of the site. Each link in the global navigation has several states - default, rollover and selected. The "selected" state is displayed to give the user a visual cue as to what section of the site the page he is currently visiting is in.
- 6 Local navigation:** This navigation area is contextual. That is, the links that appear in this area change depending on the section of the site the user is visiting. The local navigation allows the user to access all pages in a section of a site.

Depending on the section, this menu could be longer or shorter. The size of the local navigation area will stretch to accommodate the local navigation links.
- 7 Format Navigation:** In addition to the Primary Navigation links in the site masthead (see #5 above), users can also browse for KCLS.org content based on content format. Format specific sections of the site will allow users to explore the depth of the KCLS collection more fully and help them find items by format in the KCLS catalog. This navigation area appears on every page.
- 8 Audience Navigation:** In addition to finding content by format type, users can also use this navigation area to go directly to pages content that is relevant to certain audience types. This navigation area appears on every page.
- 9 HOW TO menu:** This drop-down menu contains quick links to pages on the site that will help a user complete common tasks. The options in this drop-down menu are the same as those listed in the How To area of the site's home page.
- 10 Related Links and/or Promotional Image(s):** While the Local Navigation area lists all pages to be found in the current section, the Related Links area is reserved for links to pages that do while not belong to this current section but that have content related to the content in this section. While this area appears on every page, the content of this area will change depending on the page of the site the user is visiting.
- 11 Library Locations and Hours lookup:** From any page on the site, users can instantly look up the the hours for any branch and get a link to that branch's home page on the site. Once the user logs in, the content of this area should display the information about the library associated with the user's library account.

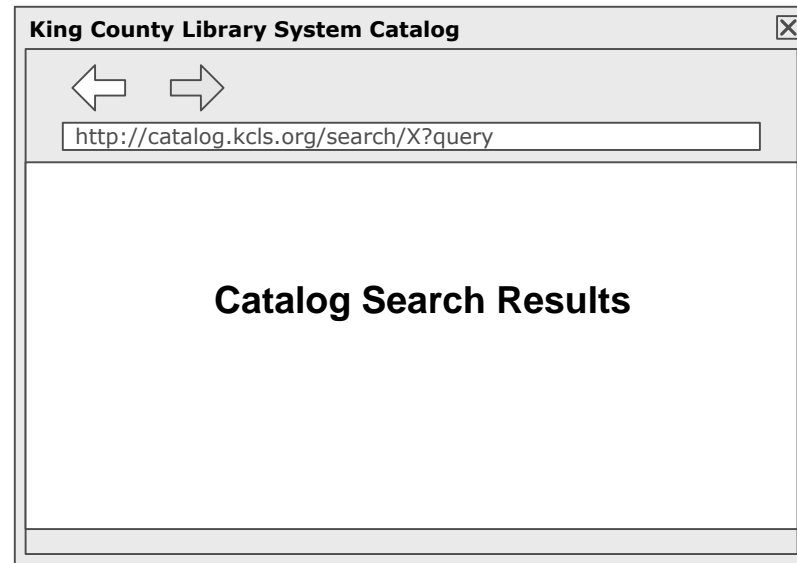
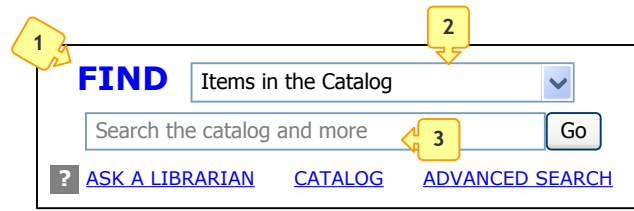

- 1 Default State: IF user has not logged in and IF user has not selected a library already, the default state displays "Find Your Library" in the location drop-down menu and gives the user a link to a page which allows him to view a map of KCLS library locations and their hours and contact information.
- 2 Once the user has selected a library OR once the user has logged in, the Locations and Hours feature displays the address, phone number and operating hours of his selected library. [If the user logs in, this feature should automatically change to display the information about the library associated with the user's library account.]

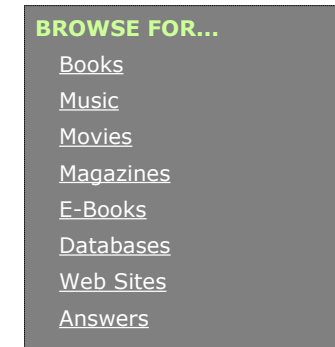

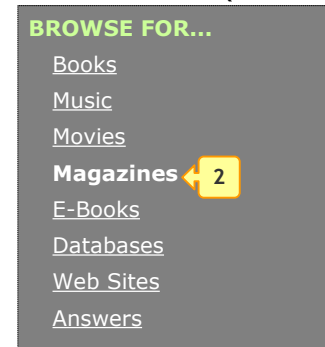


Format Navigation

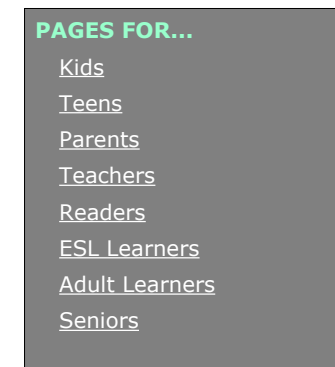

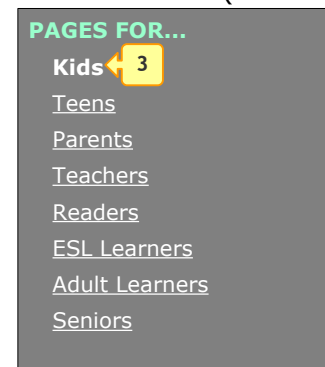

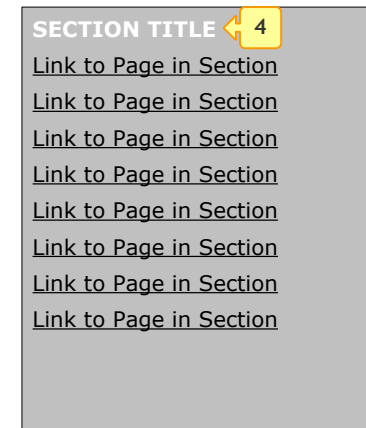

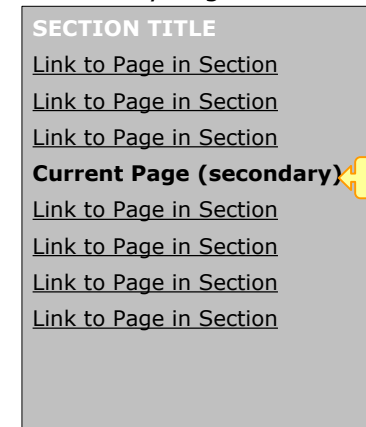

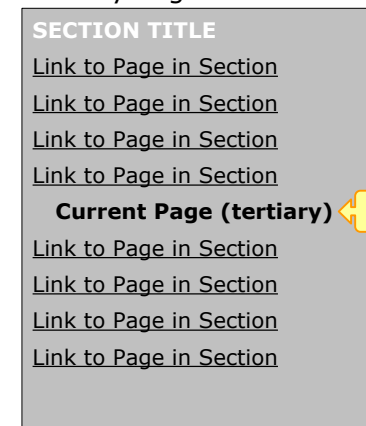

- 1 Contextual indicator shows *which main section of the site* the user is currently visiting. (In this case, the user is either on the Using the Library landing/home page or any other subpage of the Using the Library section.)
- 2 Contextual indicator shows *which Format section* the user is currently visiting. (In this case, the user is either on the Magazines landing/home page or any other subpage of the Magazines section).

If the user is not visiting any page in this section, the Format navigation appears on the page in its default state.
- 3 Contextual indicator shows *which Audience section* the user is currently visiting. (In this case, the user is either on the Kids landing/home page or any other subpage of the Kids section).

If the user is not visiting any page in this section, the Audience navigation appears on the page in its default state.
- 4 When the user clicks on any of the links in the Global Navigation, the "home" or "landing" page for that section will be displayed with the Local Navigation in this state.

The current page (the section home/landing page) is represented by the Section Title at the top of the local navigation.)
- 5 When the user clicks on any of the links in the Local Navigation, that section subpage will be displayed and the local navigation will display an indicator as to which page in the section the user is currently on. The local navigation link to the current page becomes inactive and has a different appearance from the other section subpage links.
- 6 When the user clicks on a link to a subpage in the local navigation, and if that subpage has a subpage or subpages, links to those tertiary pages will appear under the secondary page link. When the user clicks on a tertiary page, that tertiary page is displayed and the link to the page becomes inactive.

BY DEFAULT, A TERTIARY PAGE LINK WILL NOT APPEAR IN THE LOCAL NAVIGATION UNLESS THE USER CLICKS ON ITS PARENT PAGE.

Welcome to the King County Library System! Having a KCLS library card will enable you to access a wide variety of services such as borrowing materials, using subscription online databases, reserving the use of a PC within a KCLS library, and much more.

New or Existing Patron?
New Patrons:
You are invited to fill out a KCLS [library card application online](#).
• Your new library card will be mailed to you within 14 days.
• **The first time you use your new card at the library, you will be asked to present photo ID with birth date (e.g., a driver's license, Washington State ID card, or passport) and identification that verifies your current address.** If you have photo ID with birth date but not proof of address, you may check out two items at a time until address verification is provided.

Existing Patrons:
If you already have a KCLS library card, you may [apply online](#) for one of our new cards with a new design. The number on the new card you receive by mail will then be used to access your current account.

Who can get a card
Library cards are available to anyone living or owning property in the area served by the King County Library System or in the service area of another library system that has a Reciprocal Borrowing Agreement with King County Library System. Patrons visiting longer than one month but less than six months may be issued visitor's cards with a two-item limit.

AnswerFile: Notable Windstorms in Seattle History

Question: What are the worst storms in Seattle's history?

Answer:

- **December 14-15, 2006:** Wind gusts reaching 63 mph, and nearly an inch of rain fell in the area in just one hour. About 75,000 Seattle City Light customers were without power. From falling trees to carbon monoxide poisoning, electrocution, fire and drowning, the windstorm brought death in a chilling variety of ways.
- **January 20, 1993:** The Inauguration Day storm raked Western Washington with winds up to 94 mph, killing at least five people. The storm closed schools, roads and bridges and left more than 750,000 electrical customers without power and caused \$15.5 million in damage to the area's electrical system. Overall damage topped \$159 million.
- **November 22, 1991:** Thanksgiving Day storm with winds up to 60 mph.
- **November 16, 1991:** Windstorm in the night left 400,000 area households in the dark.
- **November 25, 1990:** Sections of the historic Lacey V. Murrow Floating Bridge broke apart and sank to the bottom of Lake Washington after a week of high winds and historic heavy rains. Hatches to air pockets in the pontoons had been left open, allowing them to flood.
- **December 24, 1983:** Enumclaw hit by 90 mph winds.
- **November 24, 1983:** Thanksgiving Day storm gusting to 70 mph.
- **November 14-15, 1981:** High winds.
- **February 13, 1979:** The western half of the 1.5-mile Hood Canal Bridge sank in swirling tidal currents during a storm packing winds up to 100 mph, disrupting travel to the Olympic Peninsula. The bridge reopened in 1982.
- **April 5, 1972:** Tornado with winds topping 158 mph touched down in Vancouver, Washington.
- **March 26, 1971:** Storm with winds up to 70 mph.
- **December 14, 1969:** Winds up to 60 mph.
- **January 19, 1964:** Winds up to 65 mph. (80 on the coast).
- **October 12, 1962:** The Columbus Day storm, the most violent storm on record to hit the West Coast, slammed the area with winds in excess of 70 mph. Gusts of up to 100 mph were recorded at Renton Airport. The storm, which killed seven people in Washington state, toppled trees, smashed windows and ripped the roofs off houses. About 1.5 million board feet of lumber was blown down. From Northern California to British Columbia, 46 people were killed and there was \$235 million in property damage -- \$1.29 billion in today's dollars.
- **September 28, 1962:** First recorded tornado in Western Washington.
- **October 31, 1934:** A storm containing gusts of up to 83 mph blew down a wall on the Alki Hotel, killed at least one person and ripped a trans-Pacific liner from its moorings at Pier 41.

Tips & Tricks

Phrase matching

To search for a phrase, use quotes: "book lust"

Wildcards

Use a star (*) for 1-5 characters: `mount*` matches "mountain" but not "mountaineering"

Use 2 stars (**) for any number of characters: `mount**` matches "mountain" and "mountaineering"

You may use a question mark to replace a single character anywhere within a word: `wom?n` matches "woman" and "women"

Operators

Use "And" or "Or" to specify multiple words in any field, any order. Use "and not" to exclude words. (alaska or canada) and (adventure and not vacation)

Proximity

Use "near" to specify words close to each other, in any order. home near remodel*

Field limits

Specify fields to search, using field abbreviation. Fields available for this database are a: (author), t: (title), d: (subject), N: (note). (a:tolkein) and (t:hobbit)
